Secure privileged access and passwords for all identities

- 80% of breaches involve privileged credentials
- 31% of all data breaches were caused by insider threats in 2022, with an average cost of \$15.38 million
- 59% of organizations have experienced a third-party data breach
- 74% of third-party breaches are a result of too much privileged access
- Gartner predicts that supply chain attacks will affect 45% of organizations by 2025

Lower the administrative burden of manually managing third-party access by standardizing access and eliminate sharing credentials with vendors. Consolidate management of all internal and external privileged credentials into a single solution, reducing time spent managing credentials.

Gain total visibility

Control all access

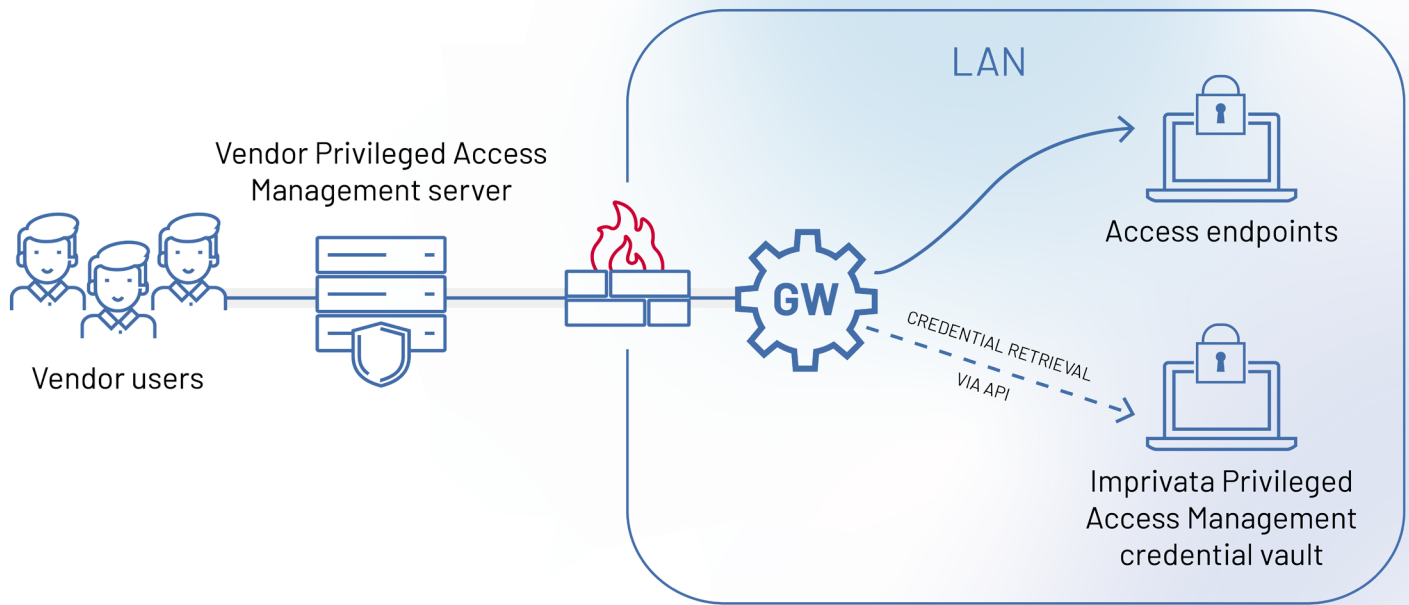

The benefits of using Imprivata Privileged Access Management and Imprivata Vendor Privileged Access Management together

Consolidate management of all credentials – both internal and external – into a single source in PAM while also recognizing all of the benefits of connectivity and identity management for third parties in VPAM.

With the integrated solutions, organizations can take advantage of the advanced vault capabilities of PAM, such as automatic password rotation or just-in-time credential provisioning. The integration does not require vendors to have a license or interface with the PAM UI. All privileged credentials remain secure against attack and misuse.



How does integration work?

- The vendor user sends a connection request, having logged in to VPAM with their own credentials
- VPAM makes an API call to PAM to retrieve masked credentials in the Password Vault, with no additional configuration in the PAM application
- Credentials are retrieved and passed to VPAM and applied to the session without user visibility

With Imprivata Privileged Access Management and Imprivata Vendor Privileged Access Management, you can improve the security of critical assets and reduce the risk of a data breach due to compromised stolen credentials.
